## Behaviour

The vast majority of children occasionally make mistakes, fall out with friends or even lash out in anger and frustration. This is all part and parcel of growing up and learning; how we respond, as adults, is crucial. When incidents happen, we support the children to deal with situations themselves and learn from them. We encourage them to take responsibility for their own actions, to forgive themselves and others, and to move forward positively, using a restorative approach. Please remember that there are always two sides to a story and bear in mind that if your child tells you about something that has happened, they will be telling it from their perspective. If you are concerned about any incident, do get in touch with the class teacher for clarification but please resist the temptation to discuss it with other parents or take ownership of the conflict from your child - consider how you would feel if it were your child being talked about negatively or if other children were discouraged from playing with them. Thank you.

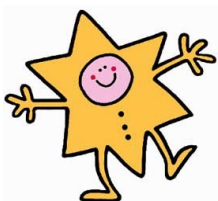
