**Class award ceremony** - Fri 16th July - morning

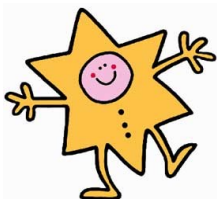
**Year group pizza and disco** - Mon 19th July 4pm to 6pm (children to stay in school - non uniform)
